What is Horizon Europe?

- The main programme for R&I funding across Europe
- 7-year programme cycle, multi-billion € budget
- Brings together Research and Innovation through various mechanisms (policy, industry and academia-focussed)
- You are funded under H2020, this is the successor Programme



How can the UK Participate after Brexit?

- UK-EU Trade And Cooperation Agreement (Brexit deal) allows the UK to become an Associated Country
- This means access to Horizon Europe on the same terms as a Member State


Key message 1: Business as usual for EU R&I Funding

- Terms of association already agreed in Brexit Deal Protocol 1, so association is a formality – just due legal process
- Association only needs to be finalised at point of GA signature for first awards – early 2022

Key message 2: UK will not miss any Horizon Europe calls

MSCA Postdoctoral Fellowship

- Formerly called Individual Fellowships in H2020
- 2-year Fellowship with a named Supervisor at Host Institution
- First international links via host partnerships etc.
- Career development focus
- Mobility still required
- Need to be ≤8 years post-Ph.D.
- Aims to be a fast-track to independence / future leadership



European Research Council (ERC)

- Prestigious Fellowship scheme
- Based on excellence: applicant track record and an ambitious, high-risk, step-change research proposal
- 3 schemes for different career stages: <u>Starter</u> (2-7 years post-Ph.D.), <u>Consolidator</u> (7-12 years post-Ph.D.), Advanced (everyone else!)
- MSCA Fellows have a better success rate



Cooperation in Science and Technology (COST)

- Network of partners to build capacity in a research area
- Funds T+S costs and some exchanges/ workshops
- Can join existing networks
